



IRRIGATION SCHEDULE CHANGES

Effective July 10, 2023

On June 27, 2023, the Moses Lake City Council approved changes to the current irrigation schedule that residents follow to water their lawns. The additional conservation measures are due to the depleted underground aquifer the City relies on for water.

The Knolls Vista Zone was experiencing lower than normal water pressures on June 22. Low water pressure is expected through the summer in the Knolls Vista Zone because of increased system demand and declining aquifer levels. This is a prime example showing why your help is needed to conserve water.

The City appreciates your patience and cooperation. Working together, we can make a difference.



NEW SCHEDULE HIGHLIGHTS

- No irrigating on Monday.
- Water conservation measures are now year-round, not just limited from June – September.
- All irrigation is prohibited from: 10 a.m. – 7 p.m., year-round.
- **Odd Addresses:** Irrigate Wednesday, Friday, Sunday
- **Even Addresses:** Irrigate Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday

ADDITIONAL CONSERVATION MEASURES

- **Unrestricted Irrigation Allowance:** Residents can obtain a permit through Public Works for 14 days of unrestricted watering when installing/planting new sod, turf, or grass seed. Please call **509-764-3951** for more information.
- Customers must stop water leaks within 96 hours of discovery or notification by the City. A shut-off will occur if leaks are not stopped after 96 hours.
- Water run-off is not allowed in the storm drain.
