Oil, heavy metals, and chemical pollution

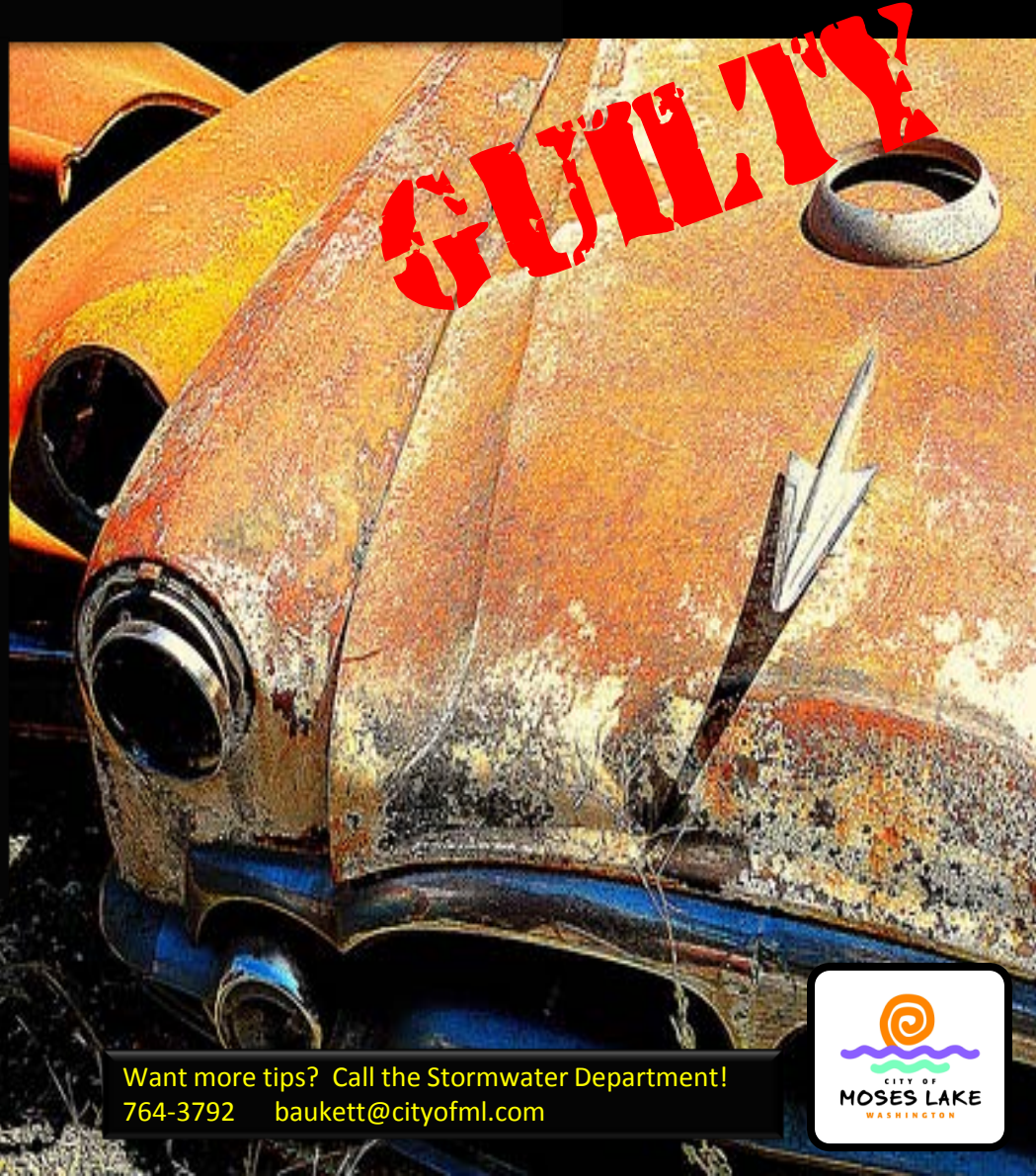
You might be surprised what your car is doing while your back is turned!

Drips and leaks are major sources of oil pollution in surface water. They fall on hard surfaces like driveways and are swept downstream by rain.

Keep your cars in good shape. Check them for leaks frequently. If you need to park a car long term, choose a location where any drips or leaks can be caught by gravel or vegetation. If you see a leak, fix it. If you can't, catch it.

Keeping leaks, drips and debris off hard surfaces keeps our watershed clean.
