When it's time to drain that pool or spa, remember your watershed!

Always drain to vegetation – not to gravel, dirt, or the gutter. Just a few feet of grass slows flow, filters any residual chemicals, and keeps solids out of the drains.

Never dump leftover pool chemicals into the drain – it's illegal, and can harm the watershed.

Wait for hot tubs to cool down before draining. Just a degree or two of temperature can be devastating to lake life.
